How to get your Chinese driver's licence in Beijing

(when you already hold a foreign licence)

It is possible to get a Chinese driver's licence (驾照) as a foreigner. If you hold a valid foreign licence, you will only have to pass a written test (unless you are the lucky citizen of an exempted country), which is available in English and a number of other foreign languages. The process has four steps. Gathering your documents, going to the office of the department of motor vehicles (DMV) to register and schedule your exam date, returning to write your exam, and finally returning to collect your licence (or having it mailed to you).

This guide aims to explain this process.

Caveat lector: The information herein was current as of <u>July 2017</u>. Procedures can change quickly, so ask around before spending time and money following these instructions. Enforcement of various rules is reportedly variable, so don't complain to me if you're not successful. You can contact the DMV directly with questions about the process, by calling them at 68397905.

Required Documents

Your journey begins by gathering all of the needed documents. If you're lucky, you'll already have most of these, and the rest are straightforward to obtain with the help of a Chinese friend, if you don't speak Chinese.

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<u>Visa</u>

Your visa can be of <u>any</u> class (including tourist), but you must be on a 90-day entry. That means that from the time you entered China, you are allowed to stay a minimum of 90 days on this current entry. It doesn't matter how much time is left on your entry, and it doesn't matter how many entries you have on your visa.

<u>Translation of your foreign driver's licence</u>

You do NOT need a certified translation. You must use the DMV form, provided in annex. You can prepare ahead of time, or they can provide you with the form when you go to the DMV -- at least, they had some printed copies when I went. Rely on this at your own risk. You can provide your own janky translation if you can write basic Chinese. The DMV personnel might help you to translate, but they appeared to be specifically prohibited from writing the characters for you. By the way, if the allowed vehicle classes are listed on your foreign licence, you shouldn't try adding new classes to your translation. They have a database of images of foreign licences along with the meanings of the various vehicle classes. I was asked whether my licence covered three-wheeled motorcycles as well (it did).

Accommodation Registration Form

This is the small-format white paper you got when you registered your place of temporary residence at your local police station. Its Chinese name is 住宿登记表. I assume it must be from Beijing, since you are applying for a Beijing driver's licence.

Medical Examination

The Chinese name for this is 机动车驾驶人身体条件证明. It's done at many government hospitals, and costs about 20RMB. It's only a vision and colourblindness test. I was asked what class of vehicle licence I was applying for, but the nurse insisted she could only put one class on the report, even though I was applying for a C1D-class licence (cars, bikes, trikes and sidecars). I got her to make two examination reports, one for C1 and one for D, and paid for both, but at the DMV they simply took the C1 examination report and amended it manually to read "C1D". When the nurse gives you the opportunity to review the examination report, do so. Mine had mistakes in it, which would have required another trip to the hospital for a new examination. I got mine done at the Peking University Third Hospital (北京大学第三医院) in Wudaokou, but other hospitals offer the same service. I've included a (perhaps dated) list of accepted hospitals in annex. Ask around for current information.

Note: You will need to pick a Chinese name for your medical examination and your driver's licence.

Photos

These are 1 inch (yi cun, 一寸) colour photos on a white background. I believe I needed six for the whole process, but don't be a cheapskate and just get a few more made, in case. Ask for "jia zhao de" (驾照的).

Registering for the Exam

Once you have gathered all of the documents, you have to go to the DMV to hand them all in and register for the written exam. Bring your Chinese friend, because no one there speaks English. The office's Chinese name is 北京市公安局公安交通管理局车辆管理所 and it is located on the southeast fourth ring road, number 18 (南四环东路18号).



After going through the security check at the gate, you will find yourself in front of an imposing building. Go around to the stairs on the left side to find the foreigners' area.






Get a number at the entrance if it's busy. The desk on the right side at the entrance is where you can get a copy of the translation form, if you don't have one already. If there are no other customers around, an officer will call you. He will process all of your documents and offer you exam dates. If you are early enough in the week, you should get an exam date for the next week. You'll pay a 50RMB fee and get a slip of paper back, which you will need on your exam day.

The Exam

You'll need to study for this. Your first resource is <u>chinesedrivingtest.com</u>, a site that offers realistic practice exams. Some people just do the exam over and over again until they are confident they can pass. As on the website, you need a minimum score of 90/100 to pass.

I also studied using a book called "Safe Driving Starts From Here", and found it very helpful. This book can be ordered by calling 63767890. There is also a PDF version floating around Wechat, so ask in the groups.



The relevant section is "Stage 1, Road Safety Laws, Regulations and Relevant Knowledge". You'll want to read the section through at least once, and pay particular attention to:

- □ Road signs
- ☐ Points system and penalties for different offences (only those of 6 and 12 points appear in the exam)
- ☐ Controls and dashboard indicators
- ☐ Jail time and other penalties for offences
- Road surface markings
- ☐ Hand signals
- ☐ Minimum and maximum speeds in various situations

If you're consistently passing the practice exam by at least a few points, you should be OK.

Exam Day

On the day of your exam, you'll go back to the same place where you registered during the last step. Bring the paper they gave you. You don't need your Chinese friend this time. When you arrive, you don't need to talk to anyone, just sit down and wait for the exam session to be announced. You'll go to the second floor and pick a computer. You'll be asked to use the keypad to enter the number underneath the bar code on your slip of paper. You pick your language and the exam starts.

If you pass, you go to the front of the class, where the attendant will shuffle a few papers, ask you to sign something, write your score on the same slip of paper you brought with you, and send you on your way. If you fail your exam on the first try, you can immediately take it again, right on the spot, without going back downstairs to the registration office. If you fail this second try, you are done for the day, and must go downstairs to register for another exam day the following week, paying the 50RMB fee again.

At this point, you can go to a counter downstairs to pay to have your new licence mailed to you. I am told the fee is 10RMB. I did not go through this process, so I have no additional information.

Picking Up Your Licence

You can pick up your licence on the third business day following your test, from 8:30am. For example, I passed on Tuesday and picked up my licence on Friday.

Picking up the licence is simple and fast. You go back to the DMV, give them the slip of paper from the exam, pay a small fee (20RMB, I believe) and walk out with your licence. I suggest bringing your documents and spare photos, just in case, but nothing more than the exam slip was required of me when I went.

You did it, champ!
